Whole class text: A variety of different traditional tales.

Writing

Fiction:

- Sentence structure (Capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.)
- Traditional and Fairy Tales – to identify and use story language.

Non-Fiction:

- Instructions – to write instructions which include features of an instruction text.
- Recounts – to understand the features of and to write a recount.

Poetry:

- Senses – to write a poem using our senses.

P.E.

Gymnastics - Developing gymnastic skills such as balancing, travelling and creating short sequences.

Fundamentals - Balancing, running, changing directions, jumping, hopping and skipping.

Reading

Through reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts, we will:

- Recognise an increasing number of High Frequency and Common Exception words
- Apply our phonic knowledge to read unfamiliar words
- Recognise alternative ways of pronouncing graphemes
- Answer retrieval questions (who, what, where, when)
- Begin to answer inference questions
- Explore the meaning of words
- Retell familiar stories in order
- Join in with repeated phrases during shared reading

Maths

- **Addition within 20**

Solving addition problems up to 20.

- **Subtraction within 20**

Solving subtraction problems up to 20.

- **Place value within 50**

Identifying the order of numbers to 50.

- **Measurement: Length & Height**

Using tools to measure length and height accurately.

- **Measurement Weight & Volume**

Using tools to measure weight and volume accurately.

Chemistry focus: Materials

- Name, identify and group the materials that objects are made out of
- Describe the physical properties of materials and explain why objects are made out of certain materials
- Test and explore the properties of different materials and think about their uses
