#### Writing:

#### Reading

##### Dinosaurs Discovered

In reading we will be continuing to focus on literal retrieval. We will also be looking at the organisational features of a non-fiction text.

We will be learning how to scan texts to retrieve answers by looking for key words and information.

#### Maths

In Maths, our main focus for the term will be to consolidate our learning by revisiting number and place value. We will also be looking at solving a range of problems based around the four operations.

Children will also be learning about fractions and decimals.

In Science our two topics will be states of matter and scientists and inventors. During our States of Matter topic, we will be looking at solids, liquids and gases and the ways in which they change.
