Swimming pool returns to Sutton Park Primary:

We are thrilled to be collaborating with Aspire Sports on another high-quality swimming provision this year. The pool is on site, meaning pupils can access it daily for an intense course of swimming instruction. Year 5 are first up and have the pool for the next 3 weeks. Year 3 will follow and the final week of the 7-week programme will enable KS2 Nurture children and any intervention swimmers pool access too.

School uniform support:

PE timetables:

At Sutton Park, pupils come to school in their PE kits on PE days. This reduces time spent getting changed and transitioning from one lesson to another. It therefore increases active time for pupils, which is so important.

In line with our school uniform policy, all students at Sutton Park Primary School are expected to wear the following items when participating in P.E:

- Maroon sports top (School logo preferred)
- Plain black shorts/leggings/jogging bottoms
- Trainers

NB: Stud earrings should not be worn on PE days so please ensure you support your child to remove these before coming to school.

When year groups are swimming, this is their PE allocation for the week. Whilst swimming, normal school uniform is therefore required daily.
