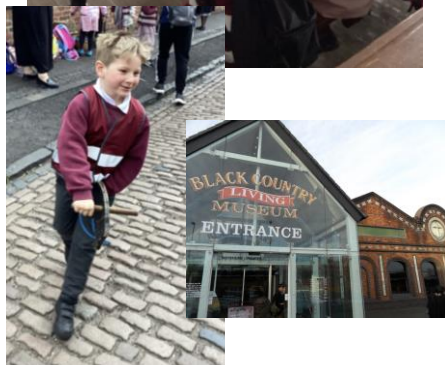

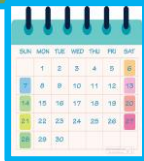
Well done to 4WS who are the only class to meet target last week.

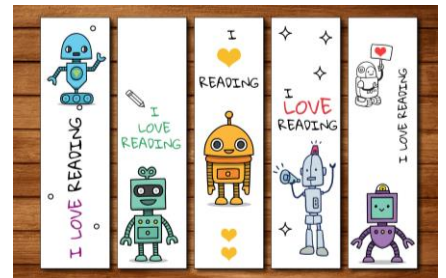
School closes for all pupils for the summer holidays at 1pm on Friday 19th July (Nursery AM children finish at usual time of 11:45)
